Got Stumps?

Support Learning Outside in Schools




This summer, San Francisco Unified School District (SFUSD) is looking for LOTS of stumps for our students to sit on in the coming fall. As you plan your next tree trimming or felling project, if you have tree trunks or branches that you can cut into usable seating stumps, please consider donating them to San Francisco Schools.

What we need:

- Seating stumps approximately 14" 19" tall and 14" 21" diameter.
- These will be used for seating in outdoor classrooms. The cuts should be straight so that the 'seat' is parallel to the ground.
- To ensure stability, the **diameter of the stumps should be greater than the height**. Example: a 14" high stump should measure **at least** 14" across.





(notice that some of these taller stumps can easily tip over)

- Teachers may appreciate back support. If you are able to, providing a back to some of the stumps would be ideal. --->
- No stumps from pine or trees with a lot of sap.
- Redwood, Eucalyptus and Monterrey Cyprus are ideal
